This exhibition works to expand the presence of the Hispanic and Latin Diaspora to the Newark downtown area art scene and expose artists to a broader audience. *Sancocho* (San-co-cho) is a traditional soup (often considered a stew) made with different methods and mixtures of ingredients depending on region. Its combinations of flavors, simmered until everything is tender and practically dissolving into an appealing broth, with the end result being a wholesome and soul feeding meal. It is this same method of joining different styles and art methods that we are achieving with this show.
